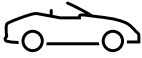
Enjoy this Auto Heritage Day Trivia ...

The **Gilmore Car Museum** has its own vast collection but also houses several independent museums on its property like Cadillac, Lincoln and Model A Ford.



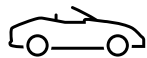
When visiting the **Plymouth Historical Museum**, learn all about the Alter Car built right there in Plymouth.

The **Henry Ford Museum of American Innovation** originally opened in June of 1933!



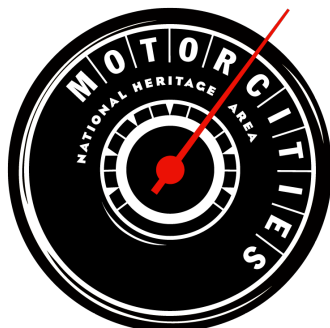
Even though the **Sloan Museum of Discovery** opened in 1966, it closed from 2019-2022 for a complete reimagining and renovation.
